About this piece

This **set of fire utensils** in **brass** belongs to the *Art Nouveau* (1890–1910) tradition, **c.1905**, European. The pair comprises long tongs with waisted shafts and scrolled terminals, and a shovel with a domed pan and upright neck. Whiplash flourishes supply the ornament, while small trefoil feet steady the tongs when set to the hearth.

Construction is direct and workshop-led, with cast and formed brass elements joined for strength and heat handling. The vocabulary is typical of turn-of-the-century metalwork, drawing movement from sinuous profiles rather than heavy decoration. The pieces are a matched pair in line and finish.
