About this piece

This **set of four Arts & Crafts oak dining chairs** was made around 1900 and embodies the ideals of the *Arts & Crafts Movement* (1880–1910), where structure, honesty of materials, and natural ornament defined domestic design.

Each chair is constructed in solid **plain-sawn oak** with a rectangular backrest pierced with stylised floral motifs and paired vertical slats. The upholstered seats rest on straight legs joined by stretchers for stability. The curved crest rail and flowing cut-outs express the hand-carved naturalism typical of late Arts & Crafts furniture, uniting form and decoration in balanced proportion.

The chairs retain their original oak finish with a warm surface patina
