About this piece

A **solid silver centrepiece**, *Modern British silver*, by **Dorothy E. Vick**. Assay marks D.E.V., Birmingham, 1945. Circular form on spreading foot with rolled rim.

This **solid silver centrepiece**, designed and made by **Dorothy E. Vick**, bears the Birmingham assay marks for **1945**, stamped *D.E.V.*. The shallow circular bowl rests on a broad spreading foot with a rolled rim, the surface planished to a soft metallic sheen. Its unembellished profile reflects the Modern British silver tradition emerging during the mid-twentieth century, where clarity of form and material integrity were favoured over ornament.

Dorothy E. Vick worked as a silversmith active in the Birmingham School circle, her pieces noted for restrained proportion and fine craftsmanship. Its timeless simplicity demonstrates the continuity of Arts and Crafts ideals within post-war British metalwork.
