About this piece

Stick and umbrella stand in oak, *Arts and Crafts* movement (1880–1910), **c.1910**. The rectangular frame carries an ordered lattice of fourteen sections above a linear base tray, an everyday furnishing conceived for entrance halls and porchways. Construction is plain and serviceable, the square uprights and rails presenting a quiet geometry consistent with British vernacular tendencies within the movement.

The restrained plan, grid organisation and absence of applied ornament place the design within the pragmatic current of *Arts and Crafts* that favoured clarity of structure and honest material presentation. The proportions read as long and low rather than tall, suited to lining a wall near a doorway while keeping walking sticks and umbrellas discrete and accessible.
