### About this piece

#### E. A. Taylor Made by Wylie & Lochhead

A rare exhibition quality Glasgow School oak sideboard with stylised hand painted floral panels. The central pointed detail is typical of **E. A. Taylor's** work, above two upper cupboards with a central plate rack and a full width plate rack below. A pair of drawers to the lower section have been cleverly designed to be a part of the angular front, with a row of drawers below flanked by a pair of large cupboards. Silver plated handles with split heart cut-outs.

To find hand painted items designed by **E. A. Taylor** and made by **Wylie & Lochhead** is extremely rare. On close inspection of the last black and white image from the period *Wylie and Lochhead* catalogue, you can actually see the paintings are identical. I have never seen another one of these sideboards, which would suggest that this may well be the very one.
