The simplicity of line and solid joinery reflect the firm's early Arts and Crafts ethos, balancing lightness of form with honest material expression. These chairs exemplify **Liberty & Co.'s** craftsmanship during the late nineteenth century, when the company promoted handmade furniture inspired by the ideals of the **Arts and Crafts Movement**.
