About this piece

This **modern Wassily chair** is a later reproduction of the original *Bauhaus design* by *Marcel Breuer* from 1925. The form is defined by a bent tubular steel frame with leather seat, back, and arm straps, expressing the Modernist principle of function refined through industrial materials.

Its clean geometry and open structure reveal Breuer's lasting influence on twentieth-century design. The leather shows a gently worn surface that adds depth and character to the chair's minimalist form.

This later example represents *Bauhaus Modernism* at its most accessible, combining elegance, practicality, and enduring appeal within modern interiors.
