### About this piece

#### Shapland and Petter

**Tub chair** in oak, aligned to the *Arts and Crafts* movement (1880–1910), c.1910. The compact tub form with enclosed arms suits a study or hall setting. A notable construction detail is the pair of back legs set at 45 degrees to the front, giving the frame a quiet stability within a simple rectilinear plan. The shaped solid seat and shaped headrest provide measured comfort without ornament, consistent with British vernacular tendencies within *Arts and Crafts*.

From a long run and **sold individually, 17 left in stock**, the model reads as a modest workshop chair that serves institutional and

domestic uses with honest construction and clear structural expression. Proportions suit desk, library, or hallway placement.
