About this piece

By **Shapland and Petter**, a **mahogany plant stand** aligned to the **Arts and Crafts movement** (1880–1910), **c.1900–1905**. The square frame rises on elongated uprights capped with **turned disc finials**, each side set with a **pierced roundel**; a lower shelf braces the legs and provides extra display. The combination of disc-topped posts and decorative cut-pierced panels is a documented S&P house vocabulary, seen on period plant stands and hall furniture. The crisp, regular piercings also reflect S&P's mechanised Barnstaple workshops, where machine-cut components were hand-finished to a high standard
