### About this piece

**Side table** in **oak** by Waring and Gillow from the *Arts and Crafts* movement (**1880–1910**), **c.1900**. The square top is supported by four slender tapering legs united by an undertier, demonstrating balance and precision in proportion. The restrained joinery and clarity of construction reflect the design ethos of the *Arts and Crafts* movement, emphasising functional honesty and natural material beauty.

Waring and Gillow, one of Britain's leading furnishing houses, produced a range of furniture informed by the ideals of craft reform while maintaining the firm's established reputation for quality. This table exemplifies their adaptation of *Arts and Crafts* principles into elegant, domestic-scale pieces suited to refined interiors of the early twentieth century.
