#### R. Whytock & Co., Of Edinburgh

Stamped. A rare pair of high Aesthetic Movement walnut ebonized and parcel gilt side chairs. An unusual pair of artistic chairs with extensive incised gilded line and floral decoration throughout, and also to the stretchers. Stamped **R. Whytock & Co., Edinburgh** under one seat (shown in the last images) and stamped only Edinburgh under the other chair.
